NORTH CAROLINA QUARTER HORSE ASSOCIATION HALL OF FAME

The North Carolina Quarter Horse Hall of Fame for outstanding individuals was founded in 1986 with the first inductees being announced in 1987.

The requirements to be eligible for nomination are being a member of NCQHA for a minimum of 15 years consecutively and be 60 years old or older. If the nominee is deceased initial membership should be a minimum of 10 years previously consecutive.

To be inducted into the Hall of Fame a nominee must be approved by at least 80% of the Hall of Fame Selection Committee.

There will be a maximum of two inductees for any or each year. Criteria to be considered for a nominee are as follows:

- 1. How has this person brought distinction to NCQHA horse Industry.
- 2. Personal attributes which make this person outstanding with NCQHA.
- 3. Significant contributions to North Carolina Quarter Horse industry.
- 4. NCQHA Achievements and/or honors.
- 5. Reasons why this person is to be honored and considered as a Hall of Fame inductee.
- 6. Someone who has devoted time above and beyond personal gain or remuneration for oneself.
